

That was deemed worthwhile, to transform SOPA at speed beyond the time and manpower constraints of its volunteer executive officers and Board. It will most likely entail increased corporate membership fees in the near future but the new value created, is expected to justify that.

Any organization that fails to renew itself, will fade. Warch for the dynamic SOPA events over 2005. Participate with vigour, benefit professionally and enjoy yourself as you do this evening. Be assured that SOPA can be relied on for quality delivery of anything it undertakes.


### These include:
